	<p>(b) Councillor Nixon had surveyed the trees around Jubilee Green and the Recreation Ground and estimated approx 100. It was agreed to check those trees that were on the A418 boundary of the Recreation Ground to see if they were on Parish Council land. It was agreed that the Clerk would go back to both companies for a revised quote. This would be circulated to all Councillors for approval before asking them to go ahead.</p> <p>(c) Following the email received from Wing Village Trust it was agreed that it would not be possible to reimburse the VAT claimed on the War memorial bills but that the Parish Council would set this amount aside for the continuing maintenance of the War Memorial. The Parish Council could consider donating towards a future Wing Village Trust project.</p> <p>(d) There were no other financial matters.</p>

Items for Discussion (a) Long Spinney (b) Recreation Ground (c) Village Green (d) Big Lunch	<p>(a) Resolution: After discussing the information circulated following the working group meeting it was PROPOSED, SECONDED and RESOLVED that the Parish Council would take the necessary steps to establish whether it would be appropriate to take on full responsibility for Long Spinney.</p> <p>(b) Councillor Naghi proposed that once the improvement to the recreation ground car park had been completed that the Parish Council starts to consider the longer term future of the recreation ground. There were grants available from places like the playing fields association to improve the facilities and it could be a good idea to look at trying to bring all the groups that use the recreation ground together to improve all the facilities. It was agreed that this was a very good idea. Councillor Crutchfield informed the meeting that the Wing Village Trust were looking at the cost of improving the fencing around the recreation ground.</p> <p>(c) Councillor Stuart reported that it might be possible to look at certain areas of land in the village to allocate as a village green. Agreed to defer further discussion on this to the next meeting of the Council.</p> <p>(d) It was agreed that following on from the Jubilee Celebrations last year it would be good to organise an event this year. It was agreed to join in with the Party in the Park events taking place all over the country and a Big Lunch would be held on 2nd June in Jubilee Green.</p>
