

Wing Parish Council Minutes to be approved at Tuesday 25th June 2013 meeting

	<p><u>Trees Jubilee Green entrance</u></p> <p>This work was completed on Thursday 23rd May and the Clerk was seeking quotes for the tarmac to be completed as soon as possible.</p> <p><u>Internal audit</u></p> <p>This has been booked for Wednesday 5th June and would take approximately 2 weeks.</p> <p><u>Bin Recreation Ground Car Park</u></p> <p>The large Eurobin that was rented from AVDC was emptied once a month at the moment but since Antonia had take over the rubbish collection in the recreation ground it was getting full much quicker. The Council currently pay £14 per month for the emptying and an increase to emptying twice a month would cost £28. It was PROPOSED, SECONDED and APPROVED that the Clerk would instruct AVDC to empty twice a month. Councillor Nixon asked that the Clerk report to AVDC that the youth shelter bin in the Recreation Ground was not being emptied.</p> <p><u>Litter Clearance</u></p> <p>The Litter clearance operative who had been employed to cover the hotspots in the village had resigned after the first month as he could not fulfil the requirements of the contract. The Council had received 2 applications for the position and this would be discussed at the end of the meeting.</p> <p><u>Correspondence received from Abbie Dixon</u></p> <p>A follow up to the original letter received informing the Council that they would be working with the Youth in the village had been received along with the report. It was agreed to send the details to the Youth Club and Police who would liase with them over this.</p> <p>(b) Councillor Stuart reported that the Project Committee had met to discuss the tender documents received for the improvement works to the recreation ground car park. She expressed her thanks to Councillors Nixon and Kelly for their input and to Paul Lambert for all his help with the tender documentation. After a lengthy discussion it had been agreed to award the contract to Keyhoe Contractors Limited at a cost of £51730.00. Whilst they were the cheapest tender they had also provided the most comprehensive information. The necessary contracts were being drawn up and it was hoped the work would commence in July/August. The social club had agreed that their car park could be used whilst the work was being undertaken apart from a couple of dates when they had events.
