

Is an annual event organised and judged by Wing Parish Council.

All gardens within Wing and Burcott are automatically entered for the two categories:

- Best front garden
- Best Hanging Baskets.

1st (gold), 2nd (silver) and 3rd (bronze) is awarded for each category and will receive a certificate as well as gardening vouchers.

We also award a number of Commendations to runners up (between 30-40) in total.

We have seen some fabulous front gardens and hanging baskets over the years and sincerely hope that this competition will spur on others in the village to also look after their front garden or have some hanging baskets.

Everyone have a chance to earn a well deserved commendation - or even winning 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize!

Wing and Burcott in Bloom is judged - at some stage - during one evening in the end of June / early July.

The judges decision is final and any gift vouchers can't be exchanged for cash.

Month of May Tidy up

The competition has been in existence since the late 1950s.

The various cups in the competition are:-

Gurney Cup (villages with a population of 500 and under)

Morris Cup (villages with a population of 500 - 1500)

DeFraine Cup (villages with a population f 1501 - 3000)

Pushman Cup (villages with a population over 3000)

Michaelis Cup (small towns)

Dashwood Trophy (for the best runner-up)

Sword of Excellence (the best overall winner)

Would it not be a great honor for the village to - if nothing else - become runner up in our category!?But to achieve this - we all have to do our bit to make it happen
