TO-DO LIST - FOR THE NEXT FEW MONTHS

As always, we meet at the Soulbury Road gate at the start of each working party.

Under the current government advice this needs to be a socially distanced working party.

This means keeping 2metres or more apart and not sharing tools.

If you borrow a tool it will be "yours" for the day.

**Substantial progress was made during the August working parties, but...
THERE IS STILL MORE OF THE SAME TO BE DONE:**

- Mowing meadow areas and raking off the cut material.
- Clearing vegetation from around existing whips and checking for survival
- Replacing any missing canes or tree guards.
- Clear understory areas of excessive bramble near paths and benches.
- Checking and repairing path edges.
- Sweep clean the board bridges and make any necessary repairs.
- Clear floatable debris from the stream (likely to be a wet and muddy job)

TOOLS REQUIRED WILL BE:

Strimmers - Rakes - Shears - Secateurs - Loppers - Spades - Stiff brushes ...
and anything you can bring that would be useful to complete the above tasks!

***We will do what we can from the list
with the tools and volunteers available.***

*If you could bring disinfectant wipe to clean tools at the end of the day
that would be much appreciated but a supply will be available on the day.*

Don't forget boots and gloves and water to keep yourself hydrated.
